MISC INSTRUCTION

- Admission test will be a mix of MCQ questions and written.
- Candidates are required to qualify separately in all sections of MCQ and written test.
- Final selection of all candidates will be made on the basis of merit with their combined marks in the written admission test for 100 marks and interview / viva-voce for 25 marks.
- The framework syllabus for written admission test is as follow:
 - General Knowledge- Bangladesh related 25 marks and Subject related 25 marks.
 - English Language and Communication 25 marks.
 - General Aptitude test and Analytical Ability 25 marks.
- Incorrect information of the candidate in the Application Form will result into cancellation of admission eligibility
- No Calculator, Mobile Phone and electronic devices will be allowed inside examination hall.
