I thank editorial Board for their sincere effort to make this happen and hope that they will continue keeping up their good works in future publications.

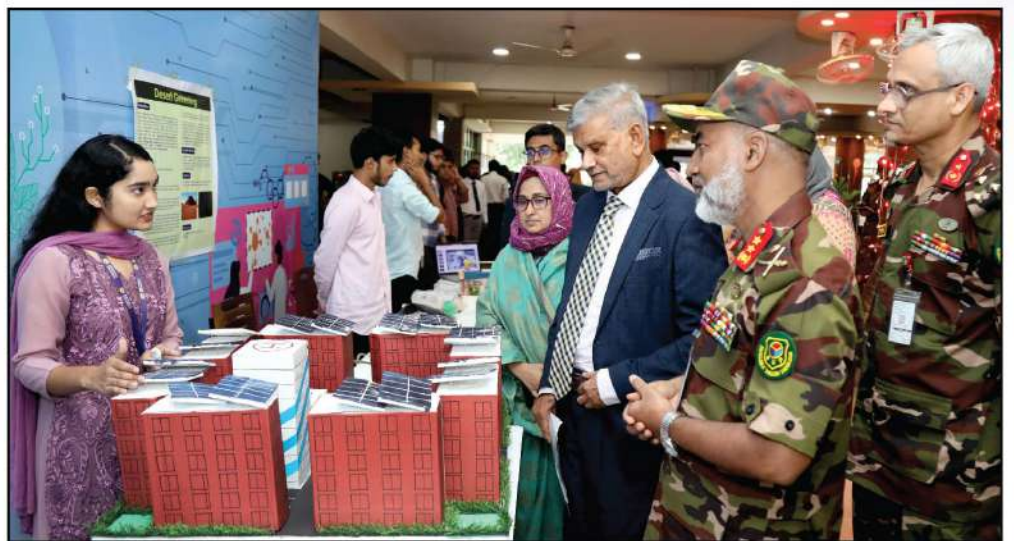
EVENTS

Environmental Fest and Workshop



Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) organized 'BUP Environmental Fest & Career Carnival-2023' and a workshop on 'Youth Participation in Climate Change Negotiations' on 04 October 2023 at BUP premises. These events focused on inspiring and motivating individuals to embrace an eco-friendly lifestyle that will prepare us for a future defined by environmentally conscious nation and make the shift sustainable. The Honourable Minister of Planning, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh M.A. Mannan, MP graced the fest as the chief guest and distributed prizes amongst the winners. Vice Chancellor of BUP Major General Md Mahbub-ul Alam, BSP, ndc, afwc, psc, MPhil, PhD, military and civil high officials, faculty members, students and invited guests from home and abroad were present in the ceremony.

This is mentionable that a total of 38 universities of Bangladesh participated in this workshop arranged by Environmental Club of BUP, Department of Environmental Science. The fest and carnival included Green Project Showcasing, Environmental Visual Art, Green Guardians, Scientific Poster Presentation and Career Expo. The workshop was planned and orchestrated by Community Development for Peace (CDP) which was attended by national and international experts.



Inter-University Policy Making Competition

The programme started on 01 October 2023 with the aim of providing a platform for undergraduates to learn and skillfully craft welfare policies. It is the largest policy-making competition in the country and a marquee event for the club. Several teams from different universities took part in the competition. Throughout the event, students encountered real-world challenges and presented efficient solutions across three interactive rounds. DU team cell No. 12 became Champion, while team Quadrant (BUP) and Gourgeoisie (IBA, DU) became 1st & 2nd runners-up, respectively. In the closing and prize-giving ceremony Professor Dr. Khondoker Mokaddem Hossain, Pro-Vice Chancellor, BUP, ornamented the event as the chief guest and distributed the prizes among the winners. Disaster Management Exercise

Inspired by the Disaster Response Exercise and Exchange (DREE), the Disaster Management Exercise (DMX) serves as a platform where students, through the resolution of case scenarios and Tabletop Exercises, impart their knowledge before a distinguished audience of experts and policymakers. On this occasion, the panelists included personalities such as Prof. Dr. Mahbuba Nasrin, ProVC of the Open University of Bangladesh; Brigadier General Husain Muhammad Masihur Rahman, SGP, SPP, ndc, afwc, psc, Director General of AFD, Bangladesh; Mr. Atiqul Huq, Former DG of the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief; Dr. Mohammed Moniruzzaman Khan, Associate Professor of IDMVS, DU; and Ms. Apurba Swatee Mahboob, a distinguished Capacity Building and Policy Advocacy Analyst from the Bangladesh Country Office of the United Nations Development Programme. In addition to having conversations with police officers, the students had the opportunity to learn about legal issues such as arrest procedures, documentation, compliance with human rights standards, and the tactics police officers use to maintain law and order, all of which help students to become law-abiding citizens of Bangladesh.

Field Visit to National Institute of Local Government

The field visit of the Department of Public Administration, Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences (FASS) held on 22 October 2023. Batch 2023 of the department went for the field visit prior to the completion of 1st Semester according to the academic guideline. In this regard, students visited National Institute of Local Government



to receive a formal training titled 'Introduction to Public Administration'. The general objective of this training course was to acquaint the participants with Legal background, Structure of LGIs & Election System, functional assignment of elected and appointed officials, human resource management, citizen participation in planning, budgeting & governance improvement, decision making system etc. At the end of the course, the participants could acquire knowledge on linking human resource management to desired general governmental outcomes by taking stock of existing jobs, such as performing job analysis, planning the nature and number of new positions, and determining appropriate compensation levels. Students learn about maintaining labour peace by working with unions during the certification process, in collective bargaining sessions, and in administering the union contract; in general, moving towards collaborative and interest-based bargaining strategies.
