MicMasters 2025

It aimed to operationalise the Arakan Recovery Plan framework for Rakhine, with particular emphasis on localising its recommendations within the context of Bangladesh. The session sought to co-develop actionable, context-specific strategies, strengthen regional cooperation and diplomatic engagement, empower local institutions and leaders, and contribute to a sustainable roadmap for repatriation, reconciliation, and security.

BUP Research Centre (BRC) conducted a training session on necessary instructions, preparations and proceedings on the Higher Education Acceleration and Transformation (HEAT) Project on 19 October 2025 at Bijoy Auditorium, BUP. The workshop focused on familiarising students with the fundamental concepts and practical applications of Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and Remote Sensing (RS) in analysing environmental changes and their implications for conflict and security. Emphasising hands-on learning, the session enabled participants to visualise and interpret spatial data related to issues such as river erosion, land loss, displacement, and human vulnerability, thereby linking field observations and case studies with geospatial patterns.

Workshop on ‘Research Methodology and Important Methodological Tools’



The Department of Development Studies, FASS, BUP, successfully organised a workshop titled ‘Research Methodology and Important Methodological Tools’ on 07 November 2025. The workshop focused on research methodology and key methodological tools used in social science and business research. It aimed to strengthen participants’ understanding of research design, data collection techniques, analytical tools, and methodological rigour. Participants gained practical insights using software such as NVivo, SPSS and SmartPLS. The workshop enhanced their analytical thinking, improved research skills, and increased their confidence in conducting rigorous academic research.

Workshop on Online Portfolio Building

The workshop significantly enhanced students’ practical understanding of no-code web design, digital self-branding, and professional online presentation, thereby contributing to their preparation for future academic and professional endeavours.

LECTURES

VISITS

Field Visit to Chandpur on Environment, Conflict, and Security



The Department of Peace, Conflict and Human Rights (PCHR), FSSS, BUP, conducted a two-day field visit to Chandpur from 08 to 09 October 2025 as part of the course PCH 2418: Environment, Conflict and Security. The visit aimed to examine how environmental degradation contributes to displacement, livelihood loss, human vulnerability, and potential conflict. Through on-site observation and engagement, participants deepened their understanding of the intersection between environmental pressures, governance challenges, and human rights concerns, thereby reinforcing the Department's commitment to experiential learning in peace, conflict, and human rights studies.

Industry Visit to Akij Bakers Ltd.



The Department of Management Studies, FBS, BUP organised an industry visit to Akij Bakers Ltd. on 28 October 2025, where approximately 50 fourth-year students participated along with faculty members. The visit aimed to expose students to real-world manufacturing operations within a leading food production enterprise. Through guided facility tours and professional interactions, participants acquired practical knowledge of industrial workflows, food safety compliance, and operational management, strengthening their industry readiness and professional competence.

Field Visit to Rural Development Academy (RDA), Bogura



As part of the course DS 5106: Field Development Exposure, the MSS2025 batch of the Department of Development Studies, FASS, BUP, undertook a five-day field visit to the Rural Development Academy (RDA), Bogura, from 26 to 30 October 2025. The purpose of this field visit was to expose students to real-world development practices, enhance their understanding of rural development initiatives, and strengthen their research competencies through hands-on project observation, data collection, and analytical exercises.

Field Trip at BMD Office Agargoan



Students of the Department of Disaster Management & Resilience, Batch 25, visited the Bangladesh Meteorological Department (BMD) on 30 October 2025 as part of their academic field visit. The visit was designed to enhance their practical understanding of meteorological concepts and their crucial role in disaster management across Bangladesh.

Fieldwork on Ecology and Soil Sciences – at Khulna University and The Sundarbans



The Department of Environmental Science, BUP, arranged a five-day fieldwork programme for the BES-23 batch from 26 to 30 October 2025. The fieldwork was conducted in Khulna, commencing with an academic visit to the Soil Archive at Khulna University, followed by ecological site explorations in the Sundarbans region. The programme aimed to provide experiential learning on soil science, agro-ecological diversity, and mangrove ecosystem dynamics. As an outcome, participants gained practical insights into soil characteristics, salinity gradients, mangrove adaptations, and the broader implications of environmental change on Bangladesh's natural landscape.

Study Tour to Cox's Bazar



The study tour of the DS-2022 batch, held from 01 to 05 November 2025, focused on exploring diverse livelihoods, environmental sustainability in tourism, cultural heritage, and socio-economic dynamics in Cox's Bazar through field visits, discussions, and critical reflections. As part of the programme, students visited Moheshkhali, Shutki Polli, the Wind Power Project, the Burmese Market, and Patuartek, where they examined local trade, fishing communities, environmental conservation efforts, and the socio-economic impact of tourism. Overall, the study tour provided an enriching academic and cultural experience, fostering stronger bonds among students and faculty members while deepening their understanding of key development themes.

Fieldwork on Ecology and Soil Sciences in the Sundarbans Mangrove Forest



The Department of Environmental Science, FST, BUP, successfully organised a five-day fieldwork programme for BES-2024 from 02 to 06 November 2025 in the Sundarbans Mangrove Forest. The fieldwork enabled students to examine ecological processes, biodiversity, soil properties, and water quality in this unique ecosystem. Overall, the programme effectively bridged theoretical knowledge with real-world environmental practice while strengthening students' research and analytical competencies.

Fieldwork on Industrial Risk, Pollution and Environmental Management at DBL Group (Mymun Complex)



The Department of Environmental Science, FST, BUP, conducted a one-day industrial fieldwork programme for MESM 2025 on 08 November 2025 at DBL Group (Mymun Complex), a leading textile industry renowned for sustainable production practices. Students explored the production units, the Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) facility, and pollution control systems, gaining firsthand experience of industrial hazards, environmental risks, and mitigation measures. The visit enhanced students' understanding of industrial sustainability, pollution control, and corporate environmental responsibility.

Visit to AFD and ISPR



The Department of Mass Communication and Journalism (MCJ), FSSS, BUP, organised an academic field visit for BSS Batch 2022 students on 25 November 2025 as part of the course MCJ 4735: Defence Journalism. The visit aimed to provide students with practical exposure to defence communication alongside theoretical learning. The programme significantly enhanced students' understanding of defence journalism, strategic communication, and civil-military coordination, contributing significantly to their professional development.
