2 (40%)	<p>The HEI/PoE did not adopt the criterion systematically but practicing occasionally/irregularly.</p> <p>No documented policy, procedure or strategy for adoption and maintenance of the criterion.</p> <p>Document(s) is/are not sufficient to demonstrate the adoption and maintenance of the criterion.</p> <p>Evidence(s) are not sufficient and clear enough to support the adoption and maintenance of the criterion.</p> <p>Need attention to address the weaknesses in system and documentation.</p>
1 (20%)	<p>The HEI/PoE did not adopt the criterion but practicing occasionally/irregularly.</p> <p>No policy, procedure or strategy for systematic adoption and maintenance of the criterion.</p> <p>No document(s) or evidence(s) is/are to support the adoption and maintenance of the criterion.</p> <p>No significant evidence(s) is/are available to support the adoption and maintenance of the criterion.</p> <p>Need serious attention to address the weaknesses in system and documentation.</p>
