Submission Checklist

You can use this list to carry out a final check of your submission before you send it to the journal for review.

Please ensure that the following items are present:

One author has been designated as the corresponding author with contact details:

- E-mail address
- Full postal address

The Manuscript should have the following information:

- Title Page (Title of the study, Corresponding author's details, Co-author's details)
- Abstract
- Keywords (maximum 6)
- Main body
- References
- All figures (include relevant captions)
- All tables (including titles, description, footnotes)
- All figure and table citations in the text match the files provided
- Indicate clearly if color should be used for any figures in print
- Graphical Abstracts/Highlights files (where applicable)
- Supplemental files (where applicable)

Authors should consider the following points before their manuscript submissions:

- This journal considers only manuscript written in English (British or American but with consistency). Authors are advised to get support from any English Editorial Service. Currently we don't have any English Editorial Service.
- References follow this journal's prescribed format
- All references mentioned in the Reference List are cited in the text, and vice versa
- Permission for 3rd party information and ethical approval (where applicable)
- Declaration of competing interest statement
- Manuscript has been 'spell checked' and 'grammar checked'
- Permission has been obtained for use of copyrighted material from other sources (including the Internet)

Submission Declaration and Verification

Submission of an article implies that the work described has not been published previously (except in the form of an abstract, a published lecture or academic thesis), that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, that its publication is approved by all authors and tacitly or explicitly by the responsible authorities where the work was carried out, and that, if accepted, it will not be published elsewhere in the same form, in English or in any other language, including electronically without the written consent of the copyright holder.

To verify originality, your article may be checked by the originality detection service *Crossref Similarity Check/turnitin etc*.

Word Limit

Articles submitted to **FASS INQUEST** should normally have a maximum word count of 6,000. Flexibility with this limit may be exercised at the discretion of the handling Editor based on the quality of the Article. In general, authors are requested to write concisely and avoid overly long articles.

Essential title page information

- *Title.* Concise and informative. Titles are often used in information-retrieval systems. Avoid abbreviations and formulae where possible.
- Author names and affiliations. Please clearly indicate the given name(s) and family name(s) of each author and check that all names are accurately spelled. Present the authors' affiliation addresses (where the actual work was done) below the names. Provide the full postal address of each affiliation, including the country name and, if available, the e-mail address of each author.
- Corresponding author. Clearly indicate who will handle correspondence at all stages of refereeing and publication, also post-publication. This responsibility includes answering any future queries about Methodology and Materials. Ensure that the e-mail address is given and that contact details are kept up to date by the corresponding author.
- Present/permanent address. If an author has moved since the work described in the article was done, or was visiting at the time, a 'Present address' (or 'Permanent address') may be indicated as a footnote to that author's name. The address at which the author actually did the work must be retained as the main, affiliation address. Superscript Arabic numerals are used for such footnotes.
