Moreover, a course on research methodology and a supervised dissertation prepare the students for in-depth methodological investigations through social research. It enables them with the capacity to serve as efficient professionals in multiple sectors, especially public service, security, development, human rights, humanitarian support, conflict management, peacekeeping, peacebuilding, and social research.

4. Eligibility for Admission

- A bachelor's degree (Hons) from any discipline with at least 2nd Class/CGPA 2.5 (out of 4.0).
- Candidates without honors (in case of having pass course degree) must have minimum 07 years of experience in their related field(s) of service
- Candidates of pass courses not having required field service experiences must have a master's degree from any discipline.

Professionals from armed forces, law enforcement agencies, NGOs, Social sciences, Political sciences, International Relations, and Peace and Conflict Studies background are highly encouraged to apply.
