Eligibility for Admission:

- A bachelor's degree (Hons) from any discipline with at least 2nd Class/CGPA 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0).
- Candidates without honors (in case of having pass course degree) must have minimum 07 years of service in their related field of experiences
- Candidates of pass courses not having required field service experiences must have a master's degree from any discipline.

Candidates from armed forces, law enforcement agencies, NGOs, Social sciences, Political sciences, International Relations and Peace and Conflict Studies background are highly encouraged.

Notes of Eligibility:

- For qualifications / degrees other than those mentioned, equivalence will be determined by Equivalence Committee of BUP.
- Eligible applicants will have to appear a Viva-Voce.
- Date, time and list of eligible candidates for Viva-Voce will be published in website and campus notice board.


Note: Those who have foreign degrees must submit the equivalence certificate issued by concerned authority in Bangladesh.
